CASE _____ AND OTHERS v. ITALY

The European Court of Human Rights, sitting on 20 September 2018 in a single-judge formation pursuant to Articles 24 § 2 and 27 of the Convention, has examined the application as submitted.

The application refers to Article 6 § 1 of the Convention and Article 1 of Protocol No. 1.

The Court, relying on its case-law (see, in particular, *Aielli and others v Italy* (dec), App. nos. 27166/18 and 27167/18, 10 July 2018), finds in the light of all the material in its possession that the matters complained of do not disclose any appearance of a violation of the rights and freedoms set out in the Convention or the Protocols thereto. Accordingly, these complaints are manifestly ill-founded within the meaning of Article 35 § 3 (a).

The Court *declares* the application inadmissible.
